All parents, grandparents etc. are invited to attend. Plan to drop your children off in class at the regular time and then go upstairs to wait for the program to begin. The children typically get upstairs about fifteen minutes after drop-off time. When the program is over we dismiss school by going outside for light refreshments and "ringing of the church bell." This tradition symbolizes the end of another school year. Your children then go home with you for the summer.
